## Return to School Plan



### EACH DAY PRIOR TO ARRIVAL:

- All students should self-assess using the included self-assessment form.

### BUSSING SCHEDULE:

- The following four locations will be the only bus stops this school year. Please have your student show up 5 minutes early:
  - Harwood Elementary School — **6:48 a.m.; After school drop off time: 2:24 pm**
  - Warren Community Center (East Parking Lot) - **6:49 a.m.; After school drop off time: 2:25 pm**
  - Siersma Elementary - **6:50 a.m.; After school drop off time: 2:23 pm**
  - Green Acres Elementary School - **6:49 a.m.; After school drop off time: 2:25 pm**
- Please go to <http://www.wcskids.net/warrcovwq/webquery/> to determine both your student's eligibility and bus stop.

### BUILDING ARRIVAL AND EXIT PROTOCOLS:

- Students **riding the bus**:
  - Enter the building through the **Main Entrance doors**.
- Students **walking to school**:
  - Enter through either the **Main Entrance doors** or **Door 20** in the rear of the building. **Both doors will open at 7:20 a.m.**
- Students **being dropped off** or **driving themselves** (*please refer to attached map*):
  - Enter the building at **Door 20** in the rear of the building, **which will open at 7:20 a.m.**
  - Student drivers must get a parking permit (NO CHARGE) from the security desk AFTER SCHOOL (license/proof of insurance/registration required).
- Late arrival:
  - Students must sign in to their house office **when entering the building after 7:57 a.m.** before reporting to their classroom.
    - Last Names **A-G**: West House Office
    - Last Names **H-N**: South House Office
    - Last Names **O-Z**: North House Office
- Exit:
  - Students must exit the building promptly at the end of the day through any door.
  - Please make arrangements with your student so you know which door is best for pick up.
  - Students waiting for a ride or the bus **must wait outside**.
  - Students are expected not to congregate in groups.

### MASKS:

- **Masks must be worn properly (covering mouth and nose) while on district property, both inside & outside, at all times without exception.**
- **Students who refuse to wear a mask properly may be recommended for virtual-only learning for the remainder of the year.**
- Masks are available in multiple locations, including all classrooms, for any student who does not have one.

## **BATHROOMS:**

- Bathrooms will be disinfected three times a day with the Clorox 360 machine.
- Every other sink/urinal is covered to allow for social distancing.
- Bathroom signage indicates capacity limits at any one time.

## **HALLWAYS:**

- Students are expected to walk **on the right side of all hallways** as indicated by floor decals and ceiling signage.
- Students are expected to avoid traveling in groups.
- Students are expected to go directly to class. There is to be no congregating in the hallways.

## **LOCKERS:**

- Students will have **no access** to lockers this year.
- Students are expected to bring backpacks/book bags to contain their belongings.

## **CLASSROOMS:**

- Upon entry, wipes are available for students to sanitize their desks/seats.
- Desks have been arranged to accommodate the 6 foot social distancing guideline.
- In most classrooms, students will have an empty desk next to them to place their belongings.
- Only one student will be allowed to leave the room at a time.
  - When leaving and subsequently returning to a classroom, the student **MUST** sign in/out.
- Students will have assigned seats and must abide by this for contact tracing purposes.'

## **DRINKING FOUNTAINS:**

- In adherence with safety guidelines, drinking fountains are not available for use.
- Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle and use the filling stations located in the Media Center and the Cafeteria.

## **BREAKFAST:**

- Breakfasts will **not** be served at WMHS.
- Breakfasts can be picked up at the following food distribution sites on Wednesdays from 7:00 a.m. — 5:00 p.m.:
  - Beer Middle School
  - Carter Middle School
  - Grissom Middle School

## **LUNCH:**

- Students will be seated at desks spaced 6 feet apart in the cafeteria.
- Each desk has a QR code for an online form. All students will complete this form each day to facilitate contact tracing. Paper versions of the form are also available in the cafeteria.
- Students are expected to wear their masks whenever they leave their desk.
- Meals will be pre-packaged with limited choices.
- There will be no a la carte.
- Lunch is free for all students.
- **Students may NOT go out to lunch.**
