

Warren Mott High School Attendance Policy 2019-2020

Consequences for Excessive UNV & EXC Absences:

***Note: MED, ACT, IHS, and SUS are exempt**

- **0 – 5 absences in any class:** Parent contacted by automated school message
- **6 absences in any class:** Student conf. w/administrator
- **10 absences in any class:** Parent contact & letter home
- **15 absences in any class:**
 - 1) Referral to Macomb County Truancy
 - 2) Student is placed on **“credit review”**:
 - If the student earns a passing grade in the class, a grade of **“FC”** will appear on his/her transcript—meaning the student will receive credit for the class, but the G.P.A. for that class will be a 0.0.
 - The student may file an appeal to his/her respective house office within five (5) business days of receiving the final grade, wherein the student will have to produce documentation of the extenuating circumstances that contributed to the excessive absences.
 - If the student passes the semester exam with a 77% (C+) or higher, the FC would be changed to a credit (CR), indicating credit earned. The letter grade from the semester coursework would not be calculated into the cumulative grade point average.
